- Overextend / put too much pressure on themselves

THE GO-WITH-THE-FLOW FOLK



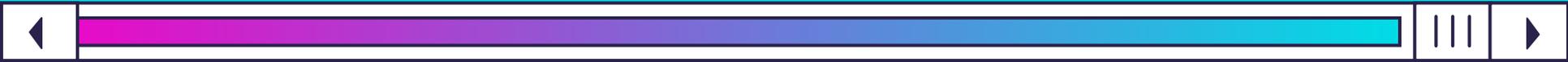
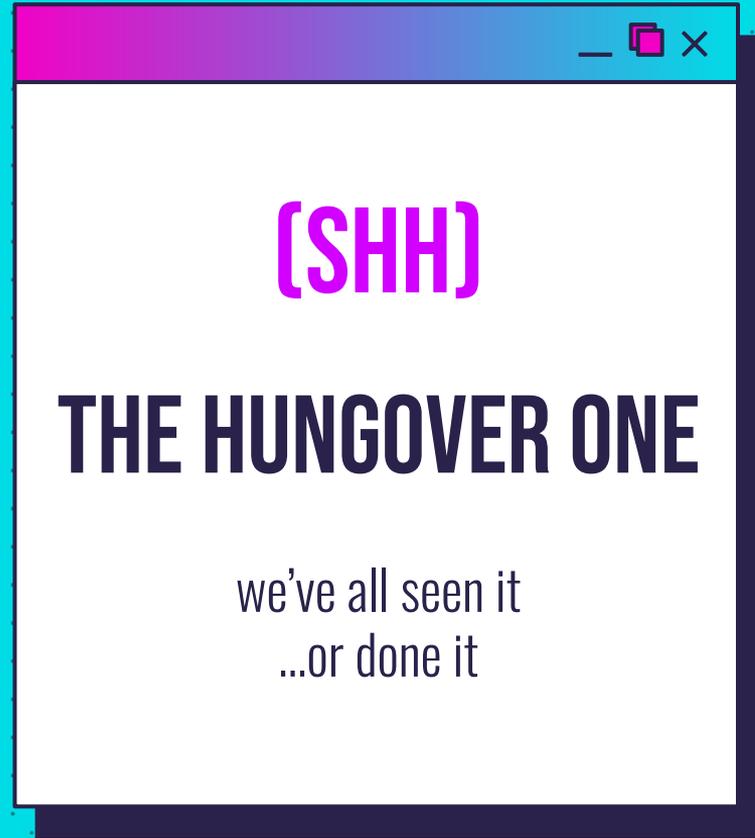
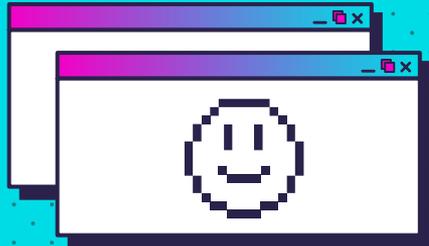
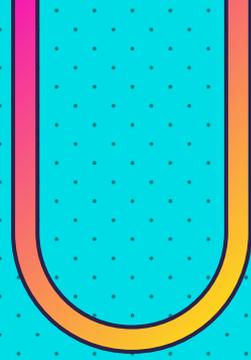
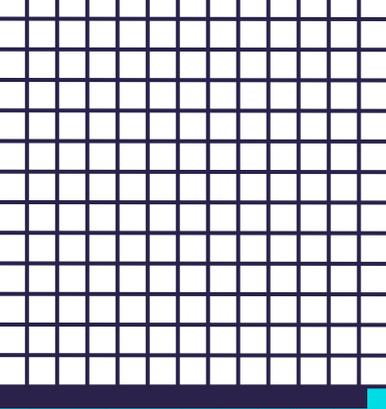
Benefits:

- Manage stamina well

- Difficult time forming an action plan to institute changes





THE NETWORKER

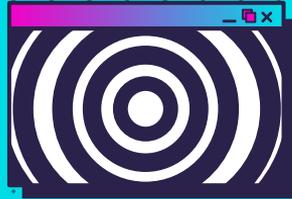
Benefits:

- Make a lot of connections outside of their norm
- Or reinforce established relationships

Risks:

- Not prepared to make process or tech changes at their org

THE SELECTIVE LISTENER



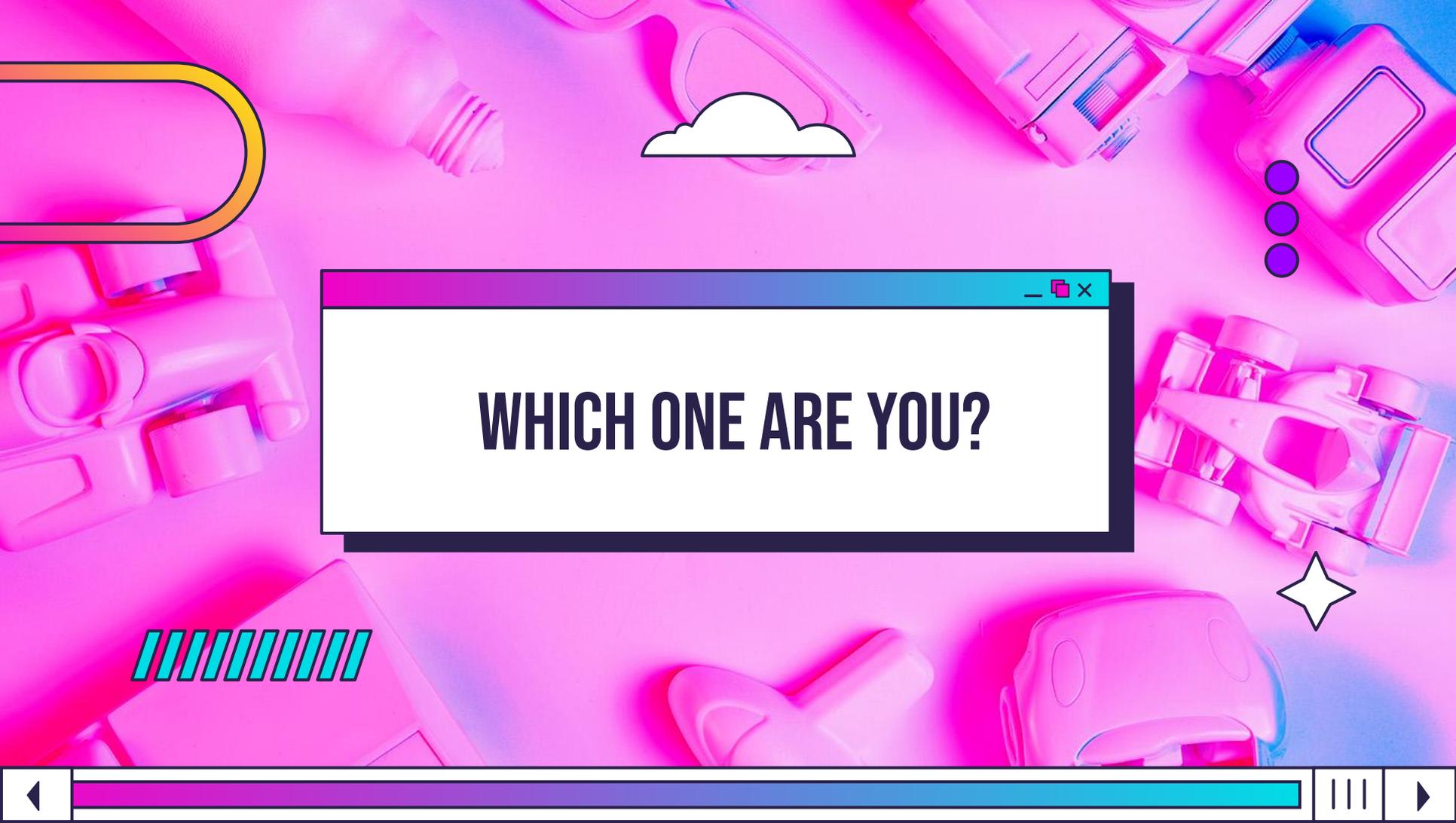
Benefits:

Risks:

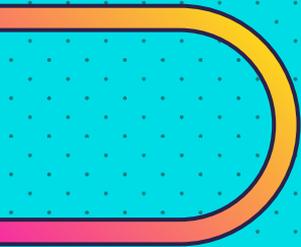
- Could miss out on opportunities by judging a talk by its title or speaker





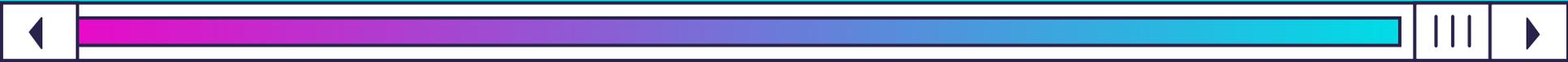
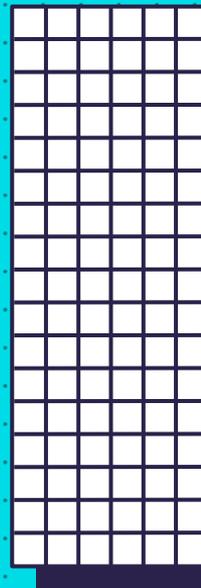

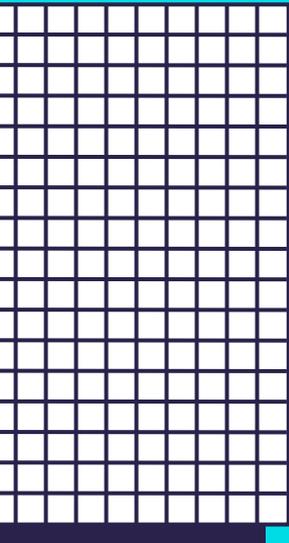
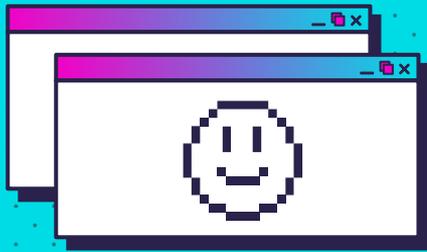




DURING THE CONFERENCE

- Take notes
- Then take more notes
- [\(here's a cool study](#) about memory)
- ...or distill your thoughts after the talk!
- Be aware of your stamina
- Nourish your body





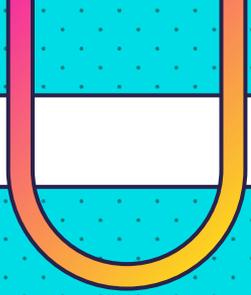
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IMMEDIATELY AFTER

- Have a large swath of notes? *Distill them down*
- **Re-evaluate your goal**, if needed!
- **Make an action plan** of 1-2 meaningful changes or philosophies you can introduce to your organization or team or code
- Resist the urge to **change too much** at once
- *...and* resist the urge to “**wait until the time is right**”

Why was it successful?



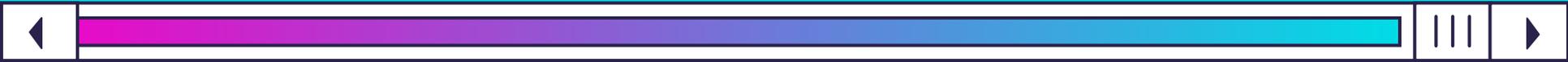
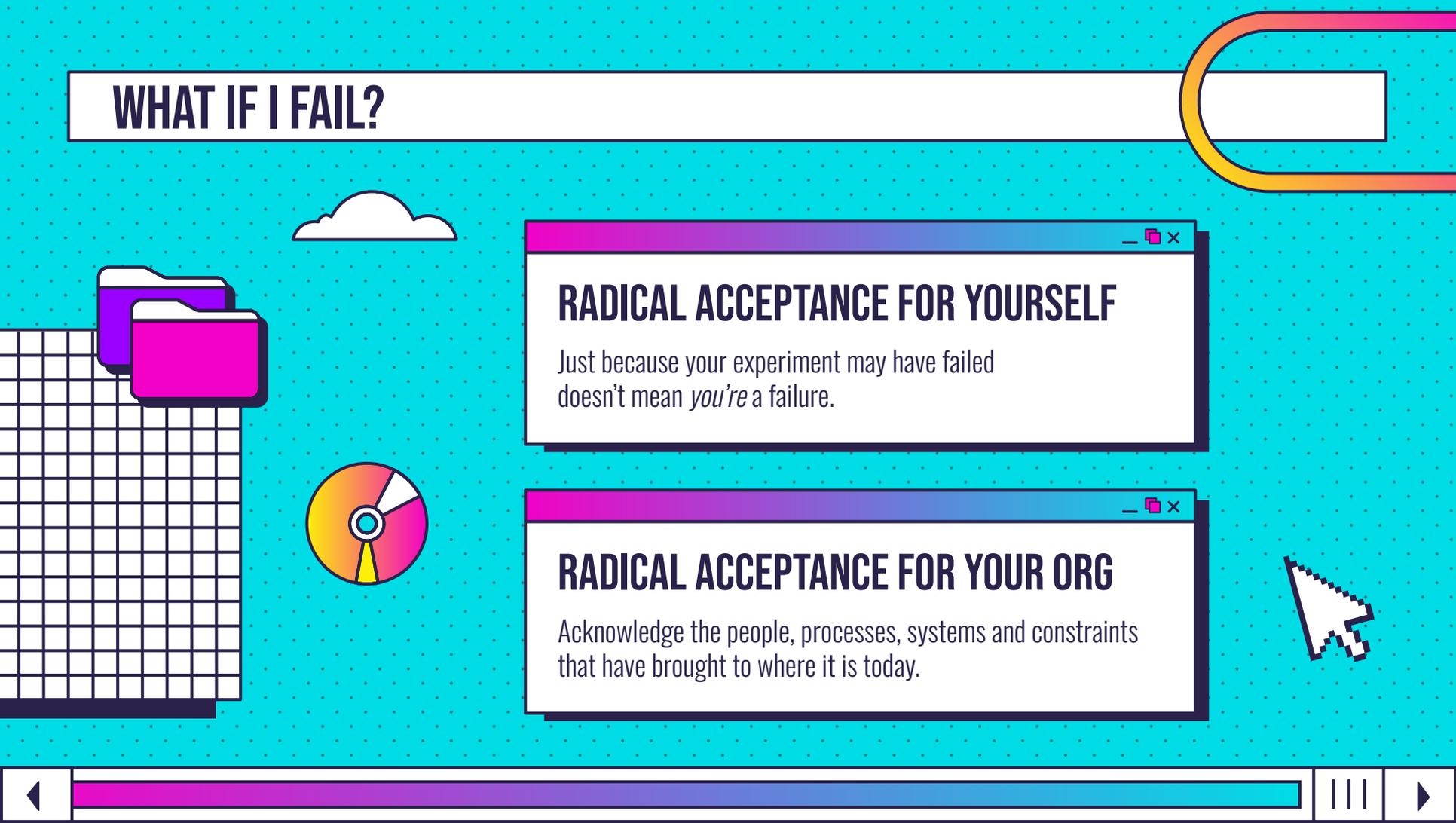
WHAT IF I FAIL?

RADICAL ACCEPTANCE FOR YOURSELF

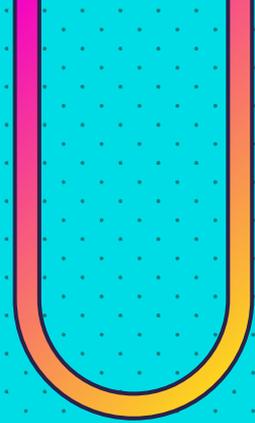
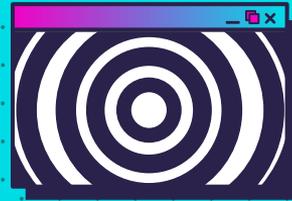
Just because your experiment may have failed doesn't mean *you're* a failure.
