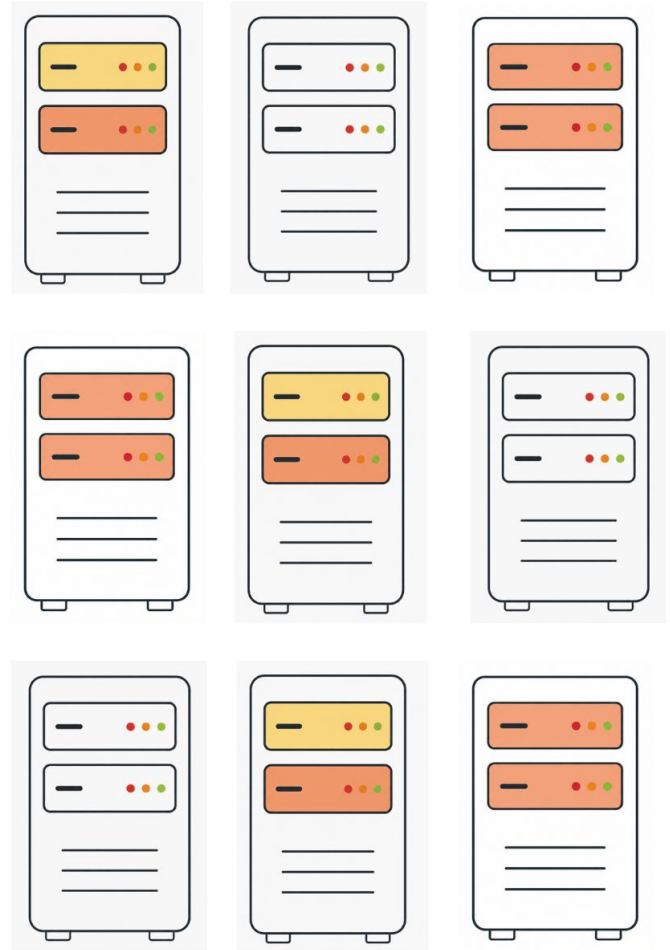

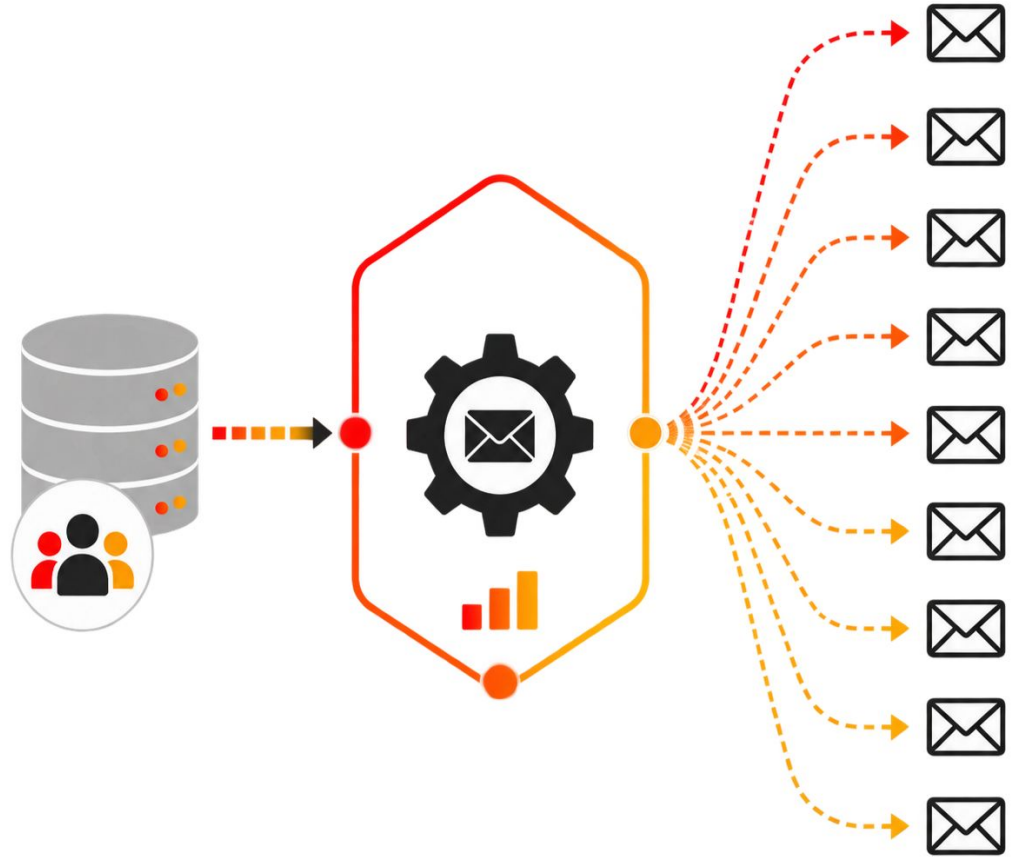

The Common Thread

THE MAGIC PHONE

Used to enable a feature.

**Making sure it stayed
alive became a side job.**

THE AUTO-DEPLOY

Built to ship the product.

**It became a second
product.**

THE EMAIL SERVICE

Built to send emails.

**It became too costly to
maintain.**

You don't see this in a design doc. You see it by *staying*.



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The Missing Feedback Loop

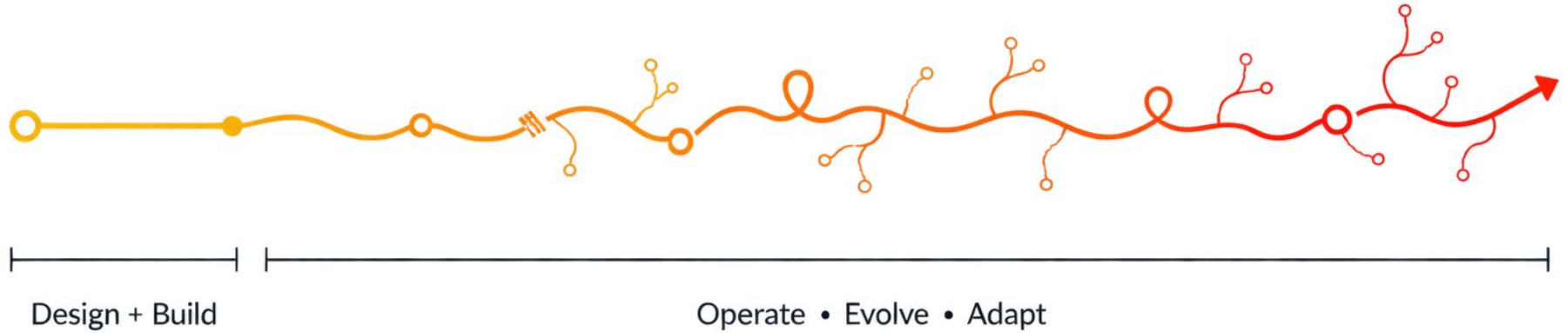
We're trained to design it.

We learn to keep it alive by *living* with it.



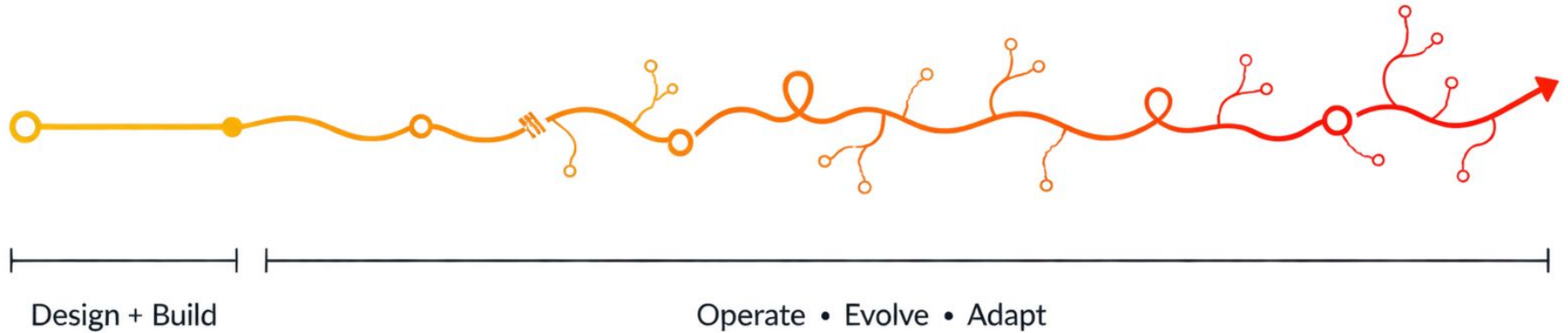

The Messaging Technology

KAFKA

Powerful, but heavy operationally, and poor support for our primary tech stack.

KINESIS

Nobody on the team had real hands-on experience operating it.

SNS + SQS

Low operational burden.

Validated directly with AWS experts.



Messaging Platform, 3.5 years later...

Backbone of **all**
asynchronous
communication
between microservices

400+ engineers relied
on it

740+ MM messages
moved per day

No real operational pain from architecture — unless AWS had a bad day.



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The Honest Undercut

Adoption couldn't keep up with governance.

Schemas proliferated.

Within two years:

- 2,000+ schemas
- Across 100+ domains

Adding oversight later could not undo the accumulated complexity.

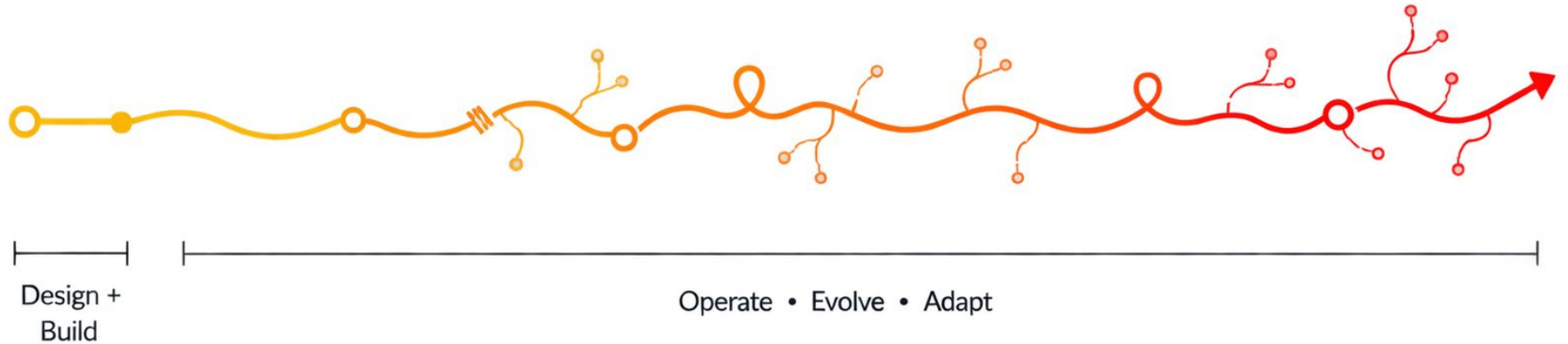


Experience alone

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The Stakes Today



Creation is getting cheaper and faster. **The long tail is still there.**



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What We Can Do

LEADERS

Use legacy work as training, not a dumping ground.

Give people context, ownership, and visibility.

Create incentives and support that help people act on their judgment.

IF YOU'RE HIRING

Don't dismiss legacy-heavy work as less strategic.

Probe for judgment.

Look for evidence of what they learned from legacy experience.

ENGINEERS

Proactively experience the long tail.

Prioritize opportunities to remove or automate work that consumes outsized team time.

Make your work—and the burden—visible so the organization to act on it



Make the Value and Burden Visible

Evaluate each through **scale, stakes, risk, and cost of inaction.**

TECHNICAL CONTEXT

- Incident frequency
- Blast radius
- Change & rollback risk
- Compounding technical debt

ORGANIZATIONAL CONTEXT

- On-call burden
- Manual coordination
- Knowledge concentration
- Delivery drag

BUSINESS CONTEXT

- Delayed features
- Customer impact
- Revenue exposure
- Compliance/Security risk



Take the Judgment With You

1. Experience the long tail
2. Prioritize high-leverage work
3. Make the value and burden visible
4. Carry the judgment into better design

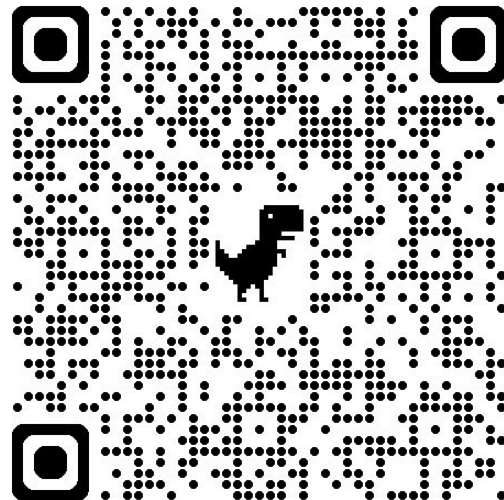
